Information on the group in DC:

There is a large population of Anglophone West Africans in the northern section of Takoma Park and the southern section of Silver Springs. We have located neighborhoods that are predominantly West African. They tend to live in the same neighborhoods as the French-speaking Africans because their cultures are very similar.

Our research has produced a limited evangelical presence for this group, but the group remains overwhelmingly unreached as a whole.
