- To a Person Jesus Christ
- >> To a Purpose Model Jesus Christ, be more like Him
- ≫ To a People You influence different people
- >> To a Passion A cause or ministry

- >> Be a leader with good influences & passion—one other want to follow
- >> Leaders touch the hearts before they ask for the hand
- >> Leadership is Influence

4 WAYS A LEADER CAN PURSUE PURPOSEFUL LEADERSHIP:

- 1. Walk in a manner worthy of your calling (Ephesians 4:1)
- 2. Fulfill the ministry set before you (2 Timothy 4:5)
- 3. Abound in the work of the Lord (1 Corinthians 15:58)
- 4. Live fruitfully (Mark 4:20)

A *mission* statement describes what a person or company wants to do now.

A *vision* statement outlines what a person or company wants to be in the future.

PERSONAL TIMELINE

Write your own timeline:

- >> When you felt called into ministry or vocation
- >> When your ministry or vocation to others began
- The milestones along the way—good and bad
- >> The different ministries or marketplaces you have been a part of
- When it all changed from serving yourself to serving others (write a word that only you know represents that time)
- >> To where you are today
- Initial under the timeline of those who have been beneficial in your journey, good and bad influences

SOMETIMES GOD REQUIRES US TO MAKE THE FIRST MOVE OUT OF OBEDIENCE TO HIS CALL.

ANSWER THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:

- Are you ready to take a risk?
- » Do you see the value of "today" versus the mentality of an eventual "one day"?
- Does change energize or paralyze you?
- Do you take responsibility for your life and decisions?
- » Are you ready to finish what you started?
- » Are you willing to do what others are note, even if that includes hard work?











SIX WAYS WE CAN PURSUE FRUITFUL LIVING:

- 1. Receive, Believe, Achieve—Heare the Word of God (daily), believe it, and then act on it.
 - But one who looks intently at the perfect law, the law of liberty, and abides by it, not having be come a forgetful hearer but an effectual doer, this man will be blessed in what he does. (James 1:25)
- 2. **Move beyond the past**—Don't allow past attempts, failures, or fears to stop you from moving forward.
 - Once you were dead because of your disobedience and your many sins. You used to live in sin, . . . All of us used to live that way, following the passionate desires and inclinations of our sinful nature. By our very nature we were subject to God's anger, just like everyone else. But God is so rich in mercy, and he loved us so much, that even though we were dead because of our sins, he gave us life when he raised Christ from the dead. (Ephesians 2:1-5 NLT)
- 3. **Goal-setter, Goal-keeper**—Make a list of what you want to accomplish, and then set deadlines. Be specific. Yes, God calls us to make plans and create deadlines, but it's important for you to be flexible when He steps in to nudge your direction.
 - The plans of the heart belong to man, but the answer of the tongue is from the Lord. The heart of man plans his way, but the Lord establishes his steps. (Proverbs 16:1 [NASB], 9 [ESV])
- 4. **Know your Why**—Know why you are doing what you are doing and be emotionally connected to the action.
 - Commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He will do it. (Psalm 37:5)
- 5. **Trust God with the outcome—**Do your part as God leads and then allow Him to complete it. Yes, following Jesus means relinquishing control and allowing Him to take the wheel. He will reveal all that you need to know for each step. Trust Him with the outcome. I found myself writing in my journal today, Give me the wisdom to search Your plans as I walk in Your ways.
 - For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them. (Ephesians 2:10)
 - For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope. (Jeremiah 29:11 ESV)
- 6. Make the move—Pray, pray, pray, and then take the step of faith needed to accomplish all God is calling you to. Hans Finzel, an author of ten books on leadership, says, "Life begins at the end of your comfort zone."
