



Bible Drill Commands:





Attention:

Drillers stand straight, one foot not extended in front of the other; keep eyes focused on the caller until the command "Start"; hold Bible at side (in either hand), with Bible spine down.



Present Bibles:

• "Participants bring Bible to waistline. Make sure your hands are flat on the back and front of the Bible. The drillers' thumbs and fingers should not extend around the sides of the Bible. Following "Present Bible," the caller announces the call.



Start:

This command is the signal for drillers to step forward (for the Quotation Drill and Completion Drill) or begin searching in their Bibles (for the Book Drill and Key Passage Drill). It is a mistake to begin searching before this command is given.




Time:

Timing begins immediately after the commend "Start" is given. A timekeeper calls out the word "Time" at the end of ten seconds. All drillers stop searching. No one may step forward AFTER the timekeeper calls "Time." The caller will call upon one driller to respond.




Thank you:

Acknowledgement given to a driller after a correct completed response. If a driller gives an incorrect response, they may have a chance for a second attempt. If they do not want to try again or still give an incorrect response, another driller will be called on for a correct response. Note: The Caller will acknowledge any drillers who have raised their hand (an admission of error), by saying "thank you number_



Attention:

After a driller has been called on and has responded the caller gives the command "Attention." If the Bible is open, close the Bible, return it to its proper position at your side. The participants return one step back to their original positions, with Bibles held at side.



Types of Drills – Children's Bible Drill:

- Quotation Drill (6 calls)
- Completion Drill (6 calls)
- Book Drill (6 calls)
- Key Passage Drill (6 calls)

Quotation Drill:

 6 calls quoted from memory (Bibles not used) All verses are taken from the current cycle of Children's Bible Drill verses. The Caller gives the reference (Example: John 3:16). After "Start" is called, if the driller knows the verse, he/she steps forward one step, prepared to quote the verse as it is stated on the Children's Bible Drill Verse Card and to give the reference. There is a 10 second allowance to step forward. Note: The driller can state the reference before and/or after quoting the verse.

Completion Drill:

 6 calls quoted from memory (Bibles not used) All verses are taken from the current cycle of Children's Bible Drill verses. The Caller reads the part of the verse that is underlined on the Children's Bible Drill Verse Card (Example: "In the beginning God"). After "Start" is called, if the driller can complete the verse, he/she steps forward one step, prepared to quote the entire verse and to give the reference. There is a 10 second allowance to step forward. Note: The driller can state the reference before and/or after quoting the verse.

Book Drill:

• 6 calls (Bible is used) The Caller gives the name of any book of the Bible (Example: Exodus). After the command "Start", the driller finds any page in the book called, places the index finger on the page, looks up and steps forward. If called on by the Caller, the driller gives the name of the Book preceding the book called, the name of the book called, and the name of the book following the one called. (Example: Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus). There is a 10 second allowance to locate the book and step forward.

- Book Tips Open Middle to the Middle– Psalms.
- Open ¾ of the way through the Bible New Testament

Key Passage Drill:

6 calls (Bible is used) Only the Key Passages in the current cycle of Children's Bible Drill verses are used. The leader states the title of the Key Passage (Example: The Ten Commandments). After the command "Start," the driller finds the passage in the Bible, places the index finger on any portion of the passage, looks up and steps forward. When called on, the driller states the title of the Key Passage and the reference (Example: The Ten Commandments: Exodus 20:3-17). The leader then asks the driller to read aloud one or more verses from the Key Passage. (Example: "Now please read verse 4 of that passage.") If the designated reference spans across multiple pages, the driller may request permission to turn the page before responding. There is a 10 second allowance to locate the passage and step forward.

Mistakes in Children's Bible Drill:



Failure to step forward in 10 seconds.



Participant gives incorrect response. This includes participant who raises a hand indicating an incorrect response.



Participant fails to keep eyes on the caller until start command is given.



Participant steps forward before the index finger is in the correct location.



Participant fails to handle the Bible according to instructions or obviously misuses the Bible..
