This dynamic one-day event was sponsored by Innovative Faith Resources in partnership with Liberty University. Designed to equip worship, production, and communications teams, the conference delivered a day packed with encouragement, education, insight, and innovation.

This year's event featured more than 45 breakout sessions led by nationally recognized experts. These sessions covered everything from ProPresenter

I come back with tools we can implement the very next week."
