Little Brother Dog

Psalm 27:1

There was a boy in the countryside in Asia whose parents called him “little brother dog” because ghosts fear dogs and therefore would not take him away. His family, like all the others from his village, feared evil spirits. They had no knowledge of our good and great God. They appeased, rather than worshipped, the gods they knew. Life was filled with fear.

When he grew up, a man from a different people group shared the Gospel with him. When he heard what the one true God had had done for him in Christ, he said, “I knew it was true.”

Once he believed, he began sharing the Good News with everyone who would listen. He would often travel many hours away from his home to tell others about Jesus.

Today, hundreds have turned from fear to faith. They no longer call their children ‘dog’ because they know the Most High God is in control.
