Our missionary prayer time today will be spent in Airdrie (say AIR-dree), a city in Alberta Province, western Canada, about a 15-minute drive north of the larger city of Calgary. To the west, the Rocky Mountains parade across the horizon.

This city of about 60,000 people is where two of our missionaries, Herwyn and Sheryl Tagle now live with their three children. Herwyn and Sheryl are natives of the Philippines. They moved to Airdrie in 2012 and the next year they were called to plant Hopelink Community Church, which is reaching mostly other Filipinos.

Through our church's Cooperative Program giving each month, our church helps pay the salary and expenses of Herwyn and Sheryl as they lead their new church. We're also supporting many other missionaries planting churches across western Canada. These missionary partners make a great support network for Herwyn and Sheryl.

Let us pray today specifically for Herwyn and Sheryl as they disciple their new believers and help them grow in faith. Can we ask the Lord to bless their ministry and use them to bring many more to faith in Christ.
