God Will Get The Glory

Life doesn't always go according to your plan. While that can be discouraging and even painful, it's okay. God hasn't written you off. God hasn't walked away. God hasn't given up on you. In fact, in those moments — and all moments — God is actively working for His glory. We might put it like this: *God's plan to get glory in your life is probably not the same as your plan for your life.* This means that just because it's not going according to your plan doesn't mean it's not going according to His.

God's promise to His people echoes true today: "I will get glory over Pharaoh and all his host, and the Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD." (v. Ex. 14:4). Even with Pharaoh hot on their heels, God was able to remind the Israelites that He was in control and that ultimately He would get glory. In any and every situation God will get glory. We can know this to be sure. Even when things aren't going the way that we anticipated or would have hoped, we can trust that God is working all things for His glory.
