(Deuteronomy 6:6)

When the sign on the back-country trail forbids me to go forward, I can be preeminently prideful, filled with a certainty of my own invulnerability. I tell myself that warning signs are for those who have less knowledge, diminished discipline, or sub-par skill. But, prideful certainty will end in disaster. Warning signs apply to all people, regardless of experience on the trail — for all who make the journey beyond the warning will face the same danger.

The signposts erected by God warn us, so that we may keep our soul from sin's pathway. But we can be preeminently prideful, filled with a certainty of our own strength to navigate trails without danger. God's Word, pressed on our minds by His Spirit, dispels our pride and directs our steps away from disaster and dishonor.
