Our Need of God's Presence

“Be strong and courageous..... For the Lord your God goes with you; He will never leave your nor forsake you.” (Deuteronomy 31:6)

This is a promise that reminds us of who we are in the sight of God. The truth of the matter is, without Him we can do nothing. We need to heed the call of God in the silence, telling us that He is the Creator we are His masterpiece: that He is righteous, and we are unrighteous: that God is boundless, and we are very limited: that God does not grow weary, and we get tired and need rest. When we realize that we are powerless and God is powerful, this is the time that we will feel the presence of the Heavenly Father.
