But now she says, "I am thankful to not only have a relationship with God, but to fellowship with people who genuinely love and care for others." Nichelle is training to be part of the church's leadership team.

Let's pray for Ken and Viktoria and their ministry in the Wilson Park area of Philadelphia. Through the power of Christ, they're helping people like Nichelle change their personal history forever.
