What do you do when you're spiritually disappointed? What do you do when God doesn't do what you think He should do? Israelites found themselves disappointed by God and they turned to an idol. "When the people saw that Moses delayed to come down from the mountain, the people gathered themselves together to Aaron and said to him, 'Up, make us gods who shall go before us.'" (Exodus 32:1). While the thought of calling our spiritual leaders to create for us a new god may seem absurd, our hearts are just as prone to wonder as the Israelites'. We're tempted to fashion a god of our own understanding that will provide the security and significance and salvation that they were looking for. However, God invites us to something better. Only God is worthy of our worship. When He doesn't do what we think He should do, or in the way, or in the time we think He should do it, we can trust that He is up to something better. Resolve today: I will not turn from Him when He calls me to patiently wait on Him. He's trustworthy. He has proven it at the cross.
