***Proverbs 27:19 As in water face reflects face, so the heart of man reflects the man.***

The heart of man is a mirror to the true nature of that man. As we consider this truth, it can be a very humbling thought. We know of the sinfulness of our own heart. Thankfully, this passage gives us some very practical advice to help us find victory over the struggles of our hearts. Verse 6 says, “Faithful are the wounds of a friend.”

It is a natural reaction of our prideful hearts to surround ourselves with people that agree with us. Verse 17 says that we need to be sharpened by those around us. The struggle is that sharpening takes place because there is friction, heat, and pressure. It is rare that we truly want to surround ourselves with people that are willing to bring friction, heat, and pressure into our lives to help confront the sinfulness of our hearts. Two questions from this passage: Are you surrounding yourself with friends that will sharpen you? Are you the kind of friend that is willing to take the time and make the effort to sharpen your friends?
