

# Study 5: Witnessing

*Our ministry to the world is largely living out the life of Christ in such a way that they can be drawn to Him. This is called a witness.*

Read Luke 24:44-48.

1. What are the disciples witnesses of?
2. How important is it to know *who* Jesus is? Read also John 14:6.
3. Look at Peter's presentation of the gospel in Acts 4:8-12.  
Notice how he emphasizes the person of Christ. What does he say about who Christ is?

He also speaks of Christ's passion (death and resurrection) and His pardon (forgiveness of sins). What does he say about each?
